

**LONDON BOROUGH OF REDBRIDGE**  
**The Redbridge (Restriction of Engine Idling) Order 20\*\***  
**(Notice of Proposal)**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Redbridge propose to make the above-mentioned Order under sections 6 and 45 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") as amended and of all other enabling powers.
  2. The general effect of the Order would be to restrict engine idling by stationary vehicles, with certain exceptions. This would facilitate civil enforcement of the contravention (through the issue of penalty charge notices under the provisions of the Traffic Management Act 2004).
  3. The Order would apply to any area of carriageway in the London Borough of Redbridge including, any area designated as a parking place, loading bay, recharging point, taxi rank and to any length of street where waiting is restricted.
  4. A copy of the proposed Order and the Council's statement of reasons for proposing to make the Order can be inspected between 9.30 a.m. and 8.00 p.m. on Monday to Friday (except on Bank Holidays) and 10.00 a.m. to 5.00 p.m. on Saturdays, until the end of six weeks from the date on which the Order is made or as the case may be, the Council decides not to make the Order, at the Central Library, Clements Road, Ilford, IG1 1EA.
  5. Any person who wishes to object or make any other representations to the Order must do so in writing, specifying the grounds for the objection, within 21 days of the date, on which this notice is published, to the Head of Highways & Transportation Strategy at the address: 10th Floor Front, Lynton House, 255 - 259 High Road, Ilford, Essex IG1 1NY or by email to: [highways.parkingdesign@redbridge.gov.uk](mailto:highways.parkingdesign@redbridge.gov.uk) quoting the reference : H&TS/CP/MG-PN/ENGIDLING
